Biographical Note: Joseph Stickney grew up in Illinois and as a young man, entered the United States Naval Academy at Annapolis. He graduated from the Academy in 1862 as a midshipman, and rose to the rank of lieutenant before being leaving the Navy to pursue a career as a newspaper reporter. Stickney served a number of years as the London correspondent for the Chicago Tribune. In 1898, he reported for the Chicago Tribune from the bridge of Admiral George Dewey's flagship *Olympia* during the Battle of Manila Bay. The Chicago Tribune was the first newspaper to break the news of the American victory at Manila Bay, securing Stickney a place in history. Stickney went on to publish a book in 1899, *Life and Glorious Deeds of Admiral Dewey*, a biography of Dewey and an account of the Battle of Manila Bay. He continued to work as a newsman until his death on May 25, 1907 at the age of 58.

Joseph Stickney married Edith Cooley, and the couple had at least two children, sons Clifford and Brewster Stickney.

Scope and Content: This collection includes materials related to Stickney's news coverage of the Battle of Manila Bay in 1898 and the 2nd Boer War in South Africa in 1899. Stickney's typewritten notes, as well as telegraphs, letters, newsclippings, and photographs make up the bulk of the collection. Noteworthy among these are a set of glass lantern slides made from the original photos taken by Stickney while onboard the *Olympia* during the Battle of Manila Bay. These are the same photographs that appear in Stickney's book *Life and Glorious Deeds of Admiral Dewey*. Also of interest is an original script from from the radio program *Historical Flashback – The Battle of Manila Bay* broadcast on June 15, 1930 from REIS WLW Studio. In the set of documents pertaining to the 2nd Boer War, there is series of love letters written by Stickney to an unnamed woman while Stickney was working as

a news correspondent during the war. These romantic letters offer a glimpse into the personal life of Stickney, revealing his thoughts and feelings while traveling under dangerous conditions in South Africa.

The remainder of the collection consists of snapshots, postcards, and diaries from the Stickney family and the Cooley family (Joseph Stickney's wife's family).

The collection also includes two cap ribbons, one from the *USS Kearsarge* and one from the *Saale* of the Norddeutscher Lloyd line, and two linen napkins embroidered with “Erasporte Manila Comandante.” A Dewey Medal with original case, engraved “Joseph L. Stickney, Voluntary Aide to Commodore,” is housed in the Curatorial Department.

Arrangement Note: This collection is arranged in two series: Joseph Stickney Papers and Family Papers. The first series consists of Joseph Stickney's personal and business notes and letters, including documents related to his career in the United States Navy and as a newspaper reporter. This series is arranged into four subseries: Battle of Manila Bay, 2nd Boer War, Cruise Memorabilia, and Miscellaneous Documents and Photos. The subseries Battle of Manila Bay and 2nd Boer War contain photos, notes, correspondence, and other documents related to Stickney's news coverage of the two events. These subseries are arranged chronologically, and only contain material created during the Battle of Manila Bay in 1898 and the 2nd Boer War in 1899-1900. Cruise Memorabilia consists of menus, passenger lists, and other ephemera collected by Stickney while traveling aboard ocean liners between 1899 and 1903. All other documents related to Stickney's career are found in the Miscellaneous Documents and Photos subseries, including material related to the Battle of Manila Bay and the 2nd Boer War that was created after the events.

Family Papers contain family snapshots, postcards, and diaries, as well as other documents related to the Stickney family, but not to Joseph Stickney himself.
