The Museum is near SEPTA bus routes 17, 21, 42, 25, 33, and 48 and SEPTA 2nd Street Station (Market-Frankfort Line).

Parking is available at the Hilton Penn's Landing Parking Garage and the DRWC flat lot. Both are located adjacent to the Museum with entry points at Walnut St. and Columbus Blvd.

The main building of the Museum is wheelchair and stroller accessible.
